Q: WHERE will the next international conference take place?

A: IASK and EnKA (Energy Kinesiology Association), the American kinesiology association are hosting a joint conference in San Francisco, June 14th through 16th 2012. The Keynote speaker at this conference will be Bruce Lipton, Ph.D. You might already know his book “The Biology of Belief”. The theme of the conference is: “The Evolution of Energy Medicine”.

The IASK board has decided to have the next conference in Brazil. The first South American international conference will take place in Rio de Janeiro May 16th through 19th 2013.
