### Minutes from the 2013 IASK 'electronic' AGM

The members voted 3 proposals unanimously.

- 1) Greta Balajthy has been elected on the Board.
- 2) The **definition** of Specialized Kinesiology in the Bylaws was improved in the following way:
  - a) Specialized Kinesiology is the art of assessing the energetic systems of a person by using precision muscle testing as a biofeedback mechanism. *Using the same feedback and Specialized Kinesiology methods, a Specialized Kinesiologist identifies appropriate protocols for promoting, restoring and maintaining balance within these energetic systems. The Practitioner uses an educational model to improve his/her clients' awareness and willingness to foster their own well-being.*
- 3) The following addition to **Membership**
  - a) Membership in IASK shall be divided into the following categories:
    4. Supporting Membership: open to students and retired specialized kinesiologists *as well as to other like-minded individuals and organizations.*

The last proposal concerning the **dues for members of associated organizations** raised many questions. The board suggests consequently to keep the dues for that category of members at half the Regular member's dues.
